

How to Use a Tubeless Tyre Repair Kit

1. Locate foreign object in the tyre and remove.
2. Use lube supplied on the tip of the probe.
3. Insert the probe into puncture.
4. Work probe rapidly in and out until the probe moves freely.
5. Remove tubeless repair string from pack.
6. Centre the repair string in the needle. Do not use glue.
7. Insert the repair string into hole with a steady even push.
Push in until only 12mm of string remains on the exterior of the tyre.
Slowly pull the needle back out of the hole.
Being careful not to remove the repair string.
8. Cut off excess so it aligns with thread.



Use soapy to check for leaks.

The repaired area will vulcanise automatically and become part of the tyre.
